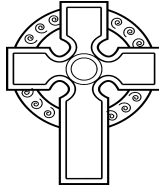

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The Eucharistic Prayers at the heart of our liturgy have a long history, beginning with the extemporaneous prayers of the early Christians. The presiders gave thanks from their hearts, not from any prearranged text, over the gifts of bread and wine. When the assembly had the sense that enough was said, someone would call out “Amen!” and that was that. For the most part, the plan flowed directly from Jewish meal prayers, which always recalled God’s mighty deeds. Some other markers and signposts were added almost everywhere fairly early, like the presider’s call to attention: “Lift up your hearts!”

Scholars have provided us with translations of many early texts. These have actually helped us craft new liturgical prayers, because until the liturgical reforms of forty years ago, no one could recall any prayer but the Roman Canon, now called Eucharistic Prayer I. For hundreds of years in the West, it was our only Eucharistic Prayer, and it was only in Latin. But the history of our Eucharistic Prayers is amazingly fruitful, and models have come down to us that have yielded new insights and expressions. The old custom of improvising texts according to a master plan has not endured, but we have now rediscovered a plan of standardizing the text while allowing for a great variety.

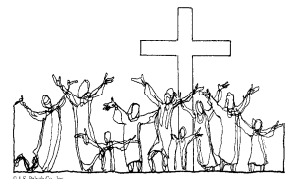
NO TENGAS MIEDO A ALGUIEN

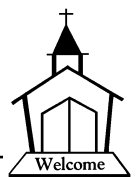

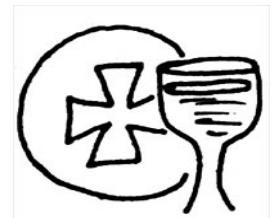

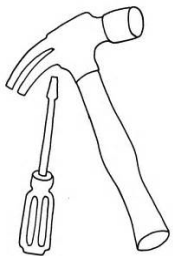
IMPROVEMENT FUND COLLECTION

Our parish was reconstructed in 1964. In 1992, there was an addition to the church, which is now the main entrance, chapel, and vestibule. Gurnell Hall and the classroom building (Parish Center) was built in 1987. Father Gurnell expressed at the completion of the Parish Center the hope that in a like spirit the people of Saint Patrick Church might come to regard the Parish Center as a place of "Christ like hospitality where people would come to celebrate their truly happy experiences... to socialize and to exercise, to learn from one another and to give witness and to minister to one another." At each Mass and church event, our parish community has lived up to Father Gurnell's hope. It should be our desire and hope that this continues as the years go by. In order for this to happen, we do need to keep our buildings in good shape. To fund the necessary parish improvements, we will have a second collection on the first Sunday of each month, starting in July. One hundred percent of the proceeds will go directly to the Improvement Fund and will be used for improvement projects as they arise. Thank you in advance for your generosity and may we continue to praise God in His home here at Saint Patrick Church!
