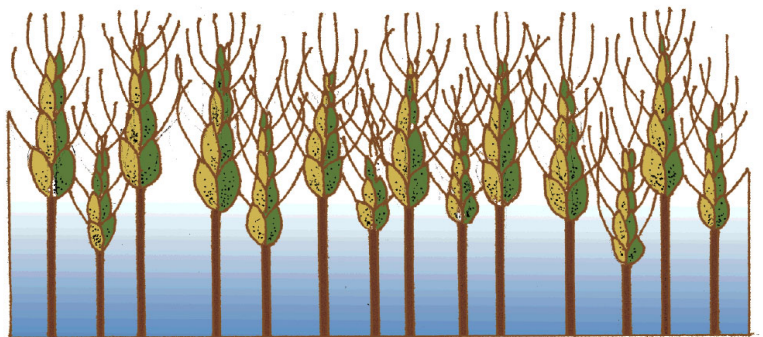

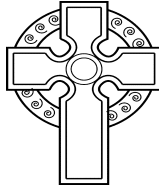
FRUIT OF THE WORD

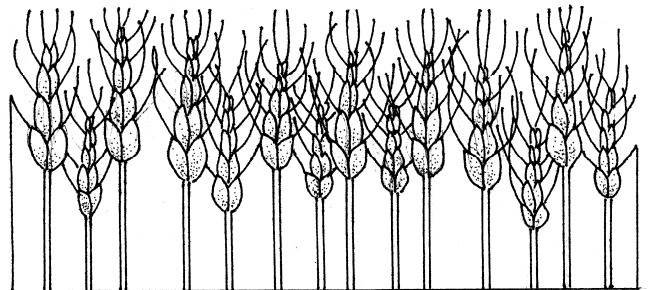

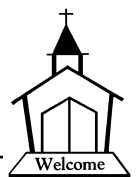

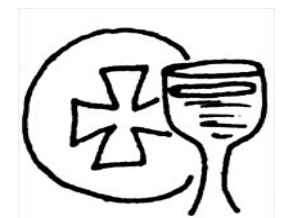

Last week, the children who attended **Catholic Kids Camp** learned about being **EARTH KEEPERS**. Did you know that **caring for God's creation** is a tenet of *Catholic social teaching*? This fact was emphasized by Pope Francis in his encyclical *Laudato Si'*, **"On Care for Our Common Home."**

A quote from *Laudato Si'*: In the Judaeo-Christian tradition, the word "creation" has a broader meaning than "nature," for it has to do with **God's loving plan** in which every creature has its own value and significance. Nature is usually seen as a system which can be studied, understood and controlled, *whereas creation can only be understood as a gift from the outstretched hand of the Father of all, and as a reality illuminated by the love which calls us together into universal communion.* (76)
